

Risk Management Plan for COVID 19 05/13/2020

Country Kids staff and participants will adhere to the following guidelines to prevent the spread of communicable disease such as COVID 19:

Everyone entering the building will complete and sign the self-declaration form.

Anyone with symptoms or who has been exposed to individuals with symptoms should not attend therapy sessions or enter the building.

Anyone with visible symptoms, or who indicates exposure in the self-declaration form will be asked to leave.

Upon entry, each person shall spray the bottoms of their shoes with Lysol or equivalent.

No gathering in the lobby. Patients will proceed directly to assigned treatment room.

Only one caregiver shall be present during a treatment session. No siblings unless special precautions and arrangements have been made.

One child, caregiver and therapist per treatment room.

Staff will wash hands prior to working with patients, after contact with potentially contaminated surfaces, and after each treatment session.

Staff will wash the hands of each patient prior to treatment using washcloth and solution provided.

Wash cloths are to be used one time only and put immediately into laundry basket.

All staff will wear masks when working with patients, or when in proximity to other staff.

Caregivers and patients shall wear masks if able.

Paper carpet roll will be placed down main hallway and into two main treatment rooms and will be disposed of daily. Wheelchairs should not be rolled onto carpeted areas unless wheels are wiped down prior.

Bathroom door, toilet and faucet handles shall be disinfected after each use and frequently throughout day. This shall also be true of microwave, refrigerator, kitchen faucet, phones, keyboards and computer mouse.

It is recommended to bring an extra shirt or two and change after direct handling of a patient.
